



J1 PARTICIPANT US TAX FILING

I am a J1 participant. Do I have to file a US tax return?

By answering the three easy questions below, you can determine if you are legally required to file a US tax return!

- Were you present in the US during 2019 on a J1 or F1 visa?
- Did you earn any US income during the 2019 calendar year?
- Did you earn any state income during the 2019 calendar year?

If you answered yes to any of the questions above, you will likely have a legal filing obligation with the IRS

Three tax rules that every nonresident should be aware of...

1. The IRS requires everyone present in the US during the 2019 calendar year on a J or F visa to file at least Form 8843
2. If you earned any US income during 2019 you will also be required to file a federal tax return
3. If you earned state income during your time in the US, you may also be required to file a state tax return
