### I am a nonresident student. Do I have to file a US tax return?

By answering the three easy questions below, you can determine if you are legally required to file a US tax return!

- Were you present in the US during 2019 on a student visa?
- Did you earn any US income during the 2019 calendar year?
- Did you earn any state income during the 2019 calendar year?

If you answered yes to any of the questions above, you will likely have a legal filing obligation with the IRS

### Three tax rules that every nonresident should be aware of...

1. The IRS requires everyone present in the US during the 2019 calendar year on a J or F visa to file at least Form 8843
2. If you earned any US income during 2019 you will also be required to file a federal tax return
3. If you earned state income during your time in the US, you may also be required to file a state tax return
